### Introduction

### What Are Cookies?

Cookies are small text files that are stored on your device when you visit a website. They help improve your browsing experience by remembering your preferences and providing relevant content.

### Types of Cookies We Use

**Functional Cookies:** These cookies enhance user experience by remembering your preferences (e.g., language, region) and customizing content accordingly.

**Analytics Cookies:** We use analytics tools (e.g., Google Analytics) to collect anonymous data about how visitors use our site. This helps us improve our content and user experience.

**Marketing Cookies:** These cookies track your browsing behaviour and allow us to display personalized ads based on your interests.

### How We Obtain Consent

We obtain your consent for non-essential cookies through a clear and unambiguous mechanism. When you visit our site, you'll see a cookie banner that explains our use of cookies. By clicking "Accept" or continuing to use the site, you agree to our cookie policy.
